 - Valid for 10 days after the USDA Accredited Veterinarian completes and signs it.
 - "Commercial" H.C.: For 6 or more privately owned pets traveling at the same time, or for pets (any number) who are traveling more than 5 days before or after the owner.
 - Valid for 48 hours after the USDA Accredited Veterinarian completes and signs it.
