 Notify VTF as soon as possible, some countries have additional requirements that are time-consuming and need to be started well in advance.

# • Breed Restrictions/ Pet Policies

- Policy came out in Aug 2018 with Breed Restrictions for on-post housing (All Army Bases)
- Some "exotic" animals are also prohibited in on-base housing

# Quarantine

- Pets must be registered with the Camp Zama VTF within 72 hours of arrival in country.
- Pets will be scheduled for an initial quarantine visit at the Camp Zama VTF as soon as possible after arrival, then re-check appointments every 30 days until quarantine is complete. Pet remains on quarantine until released by a Veterinarian at the Camp Zama VTF.
- Pets may complete any remaining quarantine ON BASE ONLY. This may be completed in the MWR Kennels or owner's on-base housing (SHA is considered on-base housing)
- Pets may not be in contact with people or pets outside the home. (No dog park, put pet in a separate room if visitors are in the home.
- Pets MUST stay on base. Travel off-base is limited to direct travel to on-base vet appointments. Pets may be taken to an off-post vet ONLY in the case of a life, limb, or eyesight emergency.

#### Vaccinations and Preventative Treatment

- The Government of Japan requires that dogs receive Rabies vaccinations every year while in Japan. 3 year vaccines are accepted for cats
- o Heartworm prevention is highly recommended for dogs in Japan
- Kennel Requirements (For boarding at the Camp Zama MWR Kennels 046 407 5915)
  - Dogs: Rabies, Distemper, Bordetella
  - Cats: Rabies, FVRCP, and FIV/FeLV Test
