Your personal and pet information falls under the Privacy Act and no one may access this information without your written and signed consent.

In order to have a caretaker bring in your pet for service/medical care, please see the following requirements below.

Owner:

The owner must supply a signed letter to the caretaker giving them permission to bring the owner's pet in for service/medical care. The letter can be as specific or as general as you like. If you want, you may also include an effective date, an expiration date, or leave it as indefinite. Please include the sponsor's full name, the pet's name, and the last four numbers of the sponsor's social security number.
